## IN CLASS GUIDELINES

**STUDENT OFFICE HOURS:** I will hold virtual student office hours. This time is for you, so don't hesitate to come by and talk about something from class or "off topic." If you aren't sure exactly what you want to talk about – that's fine too! If you want or need to meet in person, please make an appointment with me via email or before/after class.

**COMMUNICATION & CONDUCT:** The following are my expectations for how we should communicate as an ensemble. Above all, please remember to be mindful, respectful, and thoughtful.

- **Writing style:** While there is no need to participate in class discussions as if you were writing a research paper, you should remember to write using good grammar, spelling, and punctuation. - **Tone and civility:** Let's maintain a supportive learning community where everyone feels safe and where people can disagree amicably. Remember that sarcasm doesn't always come across the same to others.

**ATTENDANCE:** Class will begin on time each week. You will be marked tardy if you arrive after the class begins. Multiple tardy attendances will count as an unexcused absence. This will impact your overall participation. It is up to you to know how many absences you have over the semester. Excused absences are only granted with official written documentation. Personal e-mails are not considered official. Documentation must be provided to your instructor within one week of returning to class after the absence. Missed work may only be made up when your absence is documented and excused. It is your responsibility to follow up with your instructor on missed work. Includes: Illness, University-sponsored activity, and civic duties.

**CLASS CANCELLATION:** In the unlikely event of class cancellation due to emergency, I will contact you via e-mail or Carmen. In addition, I will contact you as soon as possible following the cancellation to let you know what will be expected of you for our next class meeting.
